Data Driven and High Impact Instruction

Increase IRLA on target levels from 54% to 70%.

Increase Reading proficiency based on FSA in the following grades: 3rd - 79% to 80%, 4th - 51% to 60%, 5th - 54% to 65%.

To increase Math proficiency based on FSA in the following grades: 3rd - 72% to 76%, 4th - 55% to 65%, 5th - 46% to 55%.

To increase Science proficiency based on FCAT Science in 5th grade from 54% to 65%.

Ongoing PD on effective IRLA conferencing with a focus on impactful power goals.

Teachers will utilize the Humanities Framework Guide to plan for ELA block.

Teams will analyze IRLA data monthly and plan for students' needs.
